

#### Long-term Recovery's Dual Agenda

| Rebuilding                            | Human services              |
|---------------------------------------|-----------------------------|
| Hard infrastructure                   | Temporary, safe housing     |
| Housing                               | Case Management             |
|                                       | Access to appropriate HC    |
| Essential systems (HC, schools, etc.) | Access to quality education |
| Local shopping                        | Public safety               |
| Recreation space                      | Social systems              |
|                                       | Jobs, economic development  |

#### Six Recovery Challenges

- 1. Failure to understand and provide for dual agenda
- 2. Persistent inability to decide on plan
- 3. Confusion among roles of various levels of government, NGOs, individuals
- 4. Lack of a designated decision-maker with resources, responsibility and accountability
- 5. Insufficient resources
- 6. Poor or absent recovery planning
